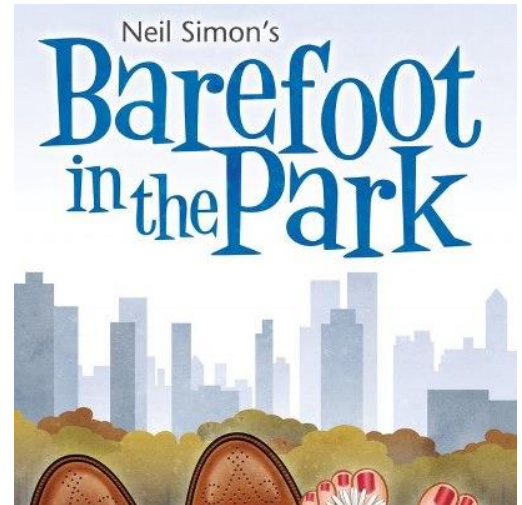




# ANNOUNCES OPEN AUDITIONS
