

Covid-19 Safety Protocols

As per the Governor's Executive Orders, certain safety measures need to be in place in order to resume operations. You will find Home Made Theater's protocols below. If you cannot, or are not willing to, adhere to these protocols, please do not plan to attend the live performance. Thank you for your cooperation. These protocols are subject to change and will be updated to stay in compliance with current standards.

All performances will be outdoors and limited to Seventy-five audience members. For the Spring Fling, Restrooms will be available in the Roosevelt 2 building, close to the performance space, before and after the performance. There is also a small café where light fare and beverages can be purchased. Restrooms will also be available at all other outdoor venues.

Check in:

You may skip the check in process by presenting your Excelsior Pass or proof of vaccination /recent negative Covid test. THIS IS NOT REQUIRED.

All others will need to complete a brief health screening questionnaire and temperature check. Verified contact information for those attending and participating MUST be provided for contact tracing purposes.

Hand sanitizing stations will be provided.

All audience members are **REQUIRED** to wear face coverings at all times, regardless of vaccination status. (This is a State requirement)

Proper physical distancing between parties, staff and crew will be enforced.

The audience will be seated with a minimum of six feet between parties.

There will be a minimum of twelve feet between the actors and audience.

All staff and crew will be required to wear face coverings (mouth and nose). Performers will wear face coverings when not on stage.
