Character Breakdown – Roles are open to all ethnicities and gender identities.

Sister Mary Regina (Mother Superior): (Mezzo-Soprano) A former circus performer who cannot resist the spotlight.

Sister Mary Hubert: (Soprano) Hubert is in charge of novices, but fancies herself a Mother Superior and is constant competition with Mary Regina. She exudes maternal wisdom to novices, but also likes to let loose.

Sister Robert Anne: (Mezzo-Soprano) Once a child delinquent herself, this rough tough nun is a jokester and constantly challenging authority. She speaks with a thick Brooklyn accent and constantly displays her lack of refinement.

Sister Mary Amnesia: (Soprano) As the name suggests, she has lost her memory and does not know who she is except that she is a nun. She is spacey and incoherent, often slipping into displays inappropriate for a nun.

Sister Mary Leo: (Soprano) Leo is the novice nun, still learning the way and coming to terms with her decision to give up "civilian" life. She is easily swayed to join in mischief.
