- ❖ In order to accommodate dietary restrictions snacks from home are permitted, however we encourage you to limit your eating to before the show and/or at intermission.
- ❖ Flash Photography and Videography are NOT PERMITTED inside the theater. We want to enjoy the show while still respecting the theater's policies.

- ❖ Slight adjustments have been made to the lighting and sound of the show. If an individual or family member experiences discomfort due to the lighting or sound, there are quiet areas they can visit just outside the high tunnel as well as utilizing the earplugs and sunglasses provided in the Sensory Kits. Our hope is to make this an enjoyable theater experience for all who attend the performance.
