WHERE:

At Home Made Theater's Wilton Mall headquarters. As we may be in the Wilton Mall past mall hours, please use Home Made Theater's "back" entrance. To find this entrance, drive around to the *exterior* entrance to JCPenney (the side of the mall facing BJ's). To the *left* of JC Penney is a loading bay. The door into the mall is in the back right corner of the loading bay. Once inside the mall, the door to Home Made Theater is a little way down the hall on the left. There is a sign and the door will be open.

SYNOPSIS:

Peter and his mischievous fairy sidekick, Tinkerbell, visit the nursery of the Darling children late one night and, with a sprinkle of pixie dust, begin a magical journey across the stars that none of them will ever forget. In the adventure of a lifetime, the travelers come face to face with a ticking crocodile, fierce warriors, a band of bungling pirates and, of course, the villainous Captain Hook.

FOR THE AUDITION:

ADULTS: Please prepare 16 bars of a Broadway song. Readings (NOT from the script) will be provided. Readings from the script will be at callbacks. Female presenting actors will dance at both the auditions and the callbacks. Male presenting actors will dance at the callbacks only.

CHILDREN: Will be taught part of "I Won't Grow Up" and will then sing by themselves. Some movement will be given, and some readings.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE:

Rehearsals will start on Sunday, January 7th. Rehearsals for the children will be Sundays only, from 1:00-5:00 until February 13th, when some weeknights will be added (though the children will be dismissed by 8:30 until tech week). Peter will rehearse on Sundays with the children, and on some weeknights. Adults will rehearse Monday, through Thursday from 6:30-9:30. Until the week before tech, rehearsals will be held at Home Made Theater's Wilton Mall headquarters. A

few days before tech week rehearsals move to the performance space at The Spa Little Theater in Saratoga Spa State Park.

Actor call is one hour prior to curtain. All performances will be held at The Spa Little Theater in Saratoga Spa State Park.

PLEASE NOTE that there will be a special matinee performance for school groups on **THURSDAY**, **FEBRUARY 29TH AT 10:00AM**. Performers must be able to miss work/school (at least for half a day) for this performance.

NOTE ABOUT CASTING

All children's roles and the role of Peter Pan will be double cast, with each "team" performing one weekend.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN:

Age ranges are approximate. This is a general guideline.
Roles are open to all ethnicities and gender identities

ADULT ROLES:

Peter Pan: Ages 18-30 (but must appear younger). Male or female presenting, but will be played as male. This character needs to embody what it's like to still be a kid but also be a leader. Must be OK with heights and lifts.

Captain Hook/Mr. Darling: Age 40+. Male presenting. A commanding presence who is ready to be in charge. Humor is a plus. Bass/Baritone

Smee: Age 25+. Male or female presenting. The best sidekick in the world. Humor a must. Bass/Baritone.

Tiger Lily: Age 30+. Female presenting. The leader of the Nartive Amazons. She commands respect and is fierce. Mezzo-Soprano.

Mrs. Darling: Age 40+. Female presenting. A woman who takes care of her family and wants them to be with her forever. Mezzo-Soprano

Native Amazonian Ensemble: Ages 18+. Female presenting. Intense dancing is a must. Limited singing. Soprano, Mezzo-Soprano, Alto.

Pirate Ensemble: Ages 18+. Male or female presenting. Humorous and fun. Gymnastic skills a plus. Tenor, Baritone, Bass-Baritone, Bass.

CHILDREN'S ROLES:

Wendy Darling: Ages 15-18. Female presenting. The maternal figure in Neverland. Commands respect but is still just a girl at heart. Must be OK with heights and lifts. Mezzo-Soprano.

John Darling: Ages 12-14. Male presenting. The sensible Darling. Ready to lead and become a man. Must be OK with heights and lifts. Tenor.

Michael Darling: Ages 8-10. Male presenting. The youngest Darling. Still has a sense of wonder about the world in him. Must be OK with heights and lifts. Tenor.

Lost Kids: Ages 8+. Male and female presenting. Peter Pan's crew. Fun and mischievous. Special talents (gymnastics, juggling, musical instrument etc.) a plus. Alto, Tenor, Baritone.
