A theater staff member will talk to the audience before the show starts to explain the changes being made for this performance including using the ASL sign to clap. Some in the audience may clap before he can explain



This play is a musical meaning that the characters will often sing their thoughts and dialogue with a live band playing backing music. The list of song can be found in your program. You can follow along to track how long it will be until intermission/the end of the play.



The sound of rain and wind may be louder in the venue.



When the music is playing there may be quick movements during dance sequences.



The stage is set “in the round” so actors are in the middle and may get close to the audience.



Stage fog and a flashing light come out of the dollhouse.



The sound of a bell tolls.



The backdrop may change suddenly at times with piece being unrolled and rolled back up quickly.



There is a thunder sound effect.



There is a crying sound effect.



At times actors may be talking or singing all at once.
